A **web page** or **webpage** is a **document** or **information resource** that is suitable for **World Wide Web** and can be accessed through a **web browser** and displayed on a **monitor** or **mobile device**. This information is usually in **HTML** or **XHTML**, and may provide **navigation** to other web pages via **hypertext links**. Web pages frequently subsume other resources such as **style sheets**, **scripts** and **images** into their final presentation.

Web pages may be retrieved from a local computer or from a remote **web server**. A web server may restrict access only to a private network, e.g. a corporate intranet, or it may publish pages on the World Wide Web. Web pages are stored and served from web **servers** using **Hypertext Transfer Protocol (HTTP)**.

Web pages may consist of files of static text and other **content** stored within the server's file system (**static web pages**), or may be constructed by **server-side scripting** when they are requested (**dynamic web pages**). **Client-side scripting** can make web pages more responsive to user input once on the client browser.
